

- Sedatives




### Drug use

### Problematic drug use




## High risk drug use


- Injection
  - Increased risk of overdose and infections
  - Prevalence of PWID varies considerably
    - Higher in some Eastern European countries
    - Lower in most African and South Asian countries
- Poly drug use
  - Prevalent among problem drug users
  - Concomitant use of different drugs may increase risk

#### Trends in drug use and harm

- May reflect
  - Price and availability changes
  - Political and societal changes




Australia 2001: Sudden decrease in heroin availability, -> increase in price and decrease in purity



USA 2011-2014: Increase in heroin availability and decrease in price & increased availability of fentanyl

#### Gender differences



- Youth drug use
  - Europe, North America
- Adult illicit drug use
- Prescription drug use
- Problem drug use
  - Europe, North America, Australia
  - Various LAMI countries

#### Age differences

- Occasional drug use concentrated among youth and young adults
- Problem drug use mostly among young to middle age adults
- Mean age of PWID has increased
  - Australia, Norway
  - Declining rates of initiation
  - Longer continuation of use
  - Later onset of problematic use

#### Drug use carreers

- Initiation often in adolescence
- Most do not progress to problem use
- Cannabis as gateway drug?
  - Variable sequencing
  - Causality?
- Problem drug use careers
  - Few long term studies
  - High mortality

#### Conclusions

- Research mainly from limited number of affluent countries
- Significant differences in extent of drug use and problem use across countries and regions
  - Reflecting variations in drug markets, legislation, and political, economic and social conditions
